

1. Downtown Joshua Tree: HDTS HQ

The HDTS HQ is located on Park Blvd about one block south of Hwy 62. Look for a big white tent on the left side of the road (to the right of Coyote Corner and directly across the street from the Park Center.) Pick up maps, the publication and HDTS t-shirts here. Amy Yao's Art Swap Meet will feature products by an array of your favorite artists. As you leave look for Landon Wigg's Welcome to Joshua Tree sign on the corner of Park and Hwy 62.

2. The Joshua Tree Saloon

This is walking distance from the HQ. The Saloon is on the south side of 29 Palms Hwy. just east of the intersection of Park Blvd.

3. Behind the Bail Bonds

From 29 Palms Hwy. and Park Dr. drive one mile to the big yellow Bail Bonds Sign. Turn RIGHT onto Neptune. Drive up Neptune. Road will veer LEFT. Follow road - park along road - please DO NOT block the turn around loop!

4. A-Z West

From site 3 you can walk up the hill towards A-Z West. The house is not open this weekend but the wash area to the west of the house is. This is where you will find Mark Kausse's phone, Carolyn Castaño's A-Z Wagon Station Customization and If you hike 20 minutes further up the wash you will find an encampment occupied by Everlovelylightningheart.

5. 29 Palms Creative Center

A the east end of of Twentynine Palms, turn right from 29 Palms Hwy on to Adobe Rd. The Creative Center is on the left side, across the street from Barr Lumber.

6. Custom Tattoo

In the center of Twentynine Palms, turn left from 29 Palms Hwy onto Adobe Rd for .8 mile. Custom Tattoo, 5783 Adobe Rd. is on the right at crest of hill. See Bette Boop in cammies on the sign.

7. Iron Age Road

From 29 Palms continue East on 29 Palms Hwy. Drive forever (23 miles) look for the sign for Iron Age Road. Turn LEFT onto the dirt road right after the sign. Drive until you come to other cars.

8. Iron Age Road

Flora's performance will begin at 6:00 on Saturday. Drive north on Iron Age road and look for parked cars and markers.

9. Chris Viet's Cabin

Continue North on Iron Age Road, eventually you will come to Amboy Road (paved) turn RIGHT and drive up the hill after the "Adios Come Again Sign" on the right hand side of the road take the first road on the LEFT. Look for signs telling when to tune into the radio station.

During the day the cabin project will be on view. At nighttime there will be a projection piece, an outside light piece and musical guests.

10. The Palms

From Site 9. head back towards 29 Palms on on Amboy Road. The Palms bar and restaurant will be on the LEFT side of the road.

11. Thom Merrick's Cabin

From the Palms turn LEFT on Amboy Road. Proceed a few miles west to Blower Road, dirt road just beyond Fire Station, sign also marked Jade Ln. Make RIGHT on Blower. Drive two miles North to 3575 Blower btw Pipeline and Valle Vista. White house on the right side. This is a drive-by work. (or park on the side of road, please don't drive over road berms, we need these intact for our Summer rainy season!)

12. Coyote Dry Lake

From the intersection of 29 Palms Hwy and Sunfair drive north (away from hills) 1.8 miles to Broadway. Turn RIGHT and drive 1.6 miles. The pavement will turn to dirt. When you get to the dry lake bed turn and drive LEFT and look for a cluster of other cars.

13. Krblin John Cabin

From the intersection of 29 Palms Hwy and Sunburst turn north. Drive a mile or two to Crestview and take a RIGHT, Drive 1.3 miles and take a RIGHT on Border again. Drive about one "block" - the Krblin John Cabin will be on your left.

14. Noah Purifoy Foundation

From the intersection of 29 Palms Hwy and Sunburst drive north. Follow the paved road as it turns RIGHT and then turns LEFT and becomes Border. Turn RIGHT on Aberdeen drive onto dirt road and turn LEFT on Center and then RIGHT again almost immediately on Blair Lane.

15. Hidden Paradise

From 29 Palms Hwy drive north on Sunburst 1.5 miles. Turn LEFT on Dennis Ave. Follow dirt road when it turns right. Turn LEFT on Hidden Paradise Drive. Park near double arrow sign and look for green flagging tape.

16. The Integratron

From 29 Palms Hwy drive north on Sunburst. Follow the paved road as it turns RIGHT and then turns LEFT and becomes Border. Drive on Border for a long time. Eventually the road will turn left and become Reche Rd. Drive a few more miles and turn right on Bellfield. The Integratron is at the corner of Belfield and Linn Rd. (Due to other Progaming the Integratron will be open between 2:00 and 4:00 on Sunday only.)

17. Andy's Gamma Gulch Site

From 29 Palms Hwy turn right at Pioneertown Road. Drive 7.5 miles up the hill, through PioneertownPipes Canyon Road. Turn LEFT on Pipes Canyon Road. Drive 2.2 miles to Gamma Gulch Rd., turn LEFT (do not drive above 20 mph on this road!!) Drive 1.6 miles to God's Way Love, turn RIGHT. Drive .4 miles to the green flagging tape on your right

18. Justus Motter's Place

From 29 Palms Hwy turn north on Pioneertown Road. Drive into hills approx. 2 miles, on the left you should see a small driveway with the address 6458 Pioneertownroad. Park along side of Hwy - or look for green flagging tape and further parking instructions. Walk up driveway - tour starts at Dome at 4:00 PM.
