HDTS 2013: October 12-19, 2013 60 independent projects from Joshua Tree to Albuquerque

Joshua Tree, **CA**—High Desert Test Sites hits the road for a full week of experimental art and exploration, from Joshua Tree to Albuquerque!

HDTS 2013 is the ninth program in a series of free ranging and ever evolving contemporary art events. 60 independent projects will take place over an entire week, during which artists and audience alike will traverse over 700 miles of desert roads to check out the new work and explore the hidden gems and diverse desert communities along this spectacular stretch of the Southwest.

Each day of the event will focus on a specific leg of the route between Joshua Tree and Albuquerque—highlighting independent projects, performances, installations, and points of interest along the way:

October 12-13: Joshua Tree area

October 14: Amboy through Kingman

October 15: Crown King October 16: Arcosanti

October 17: Turkey Springs; Gallup

October 18: Belen, Los Lunas, Magdalena

October 19: Albuquerque area
