3. TROPHY MODERN HOUSE (JOSHUA TREE)

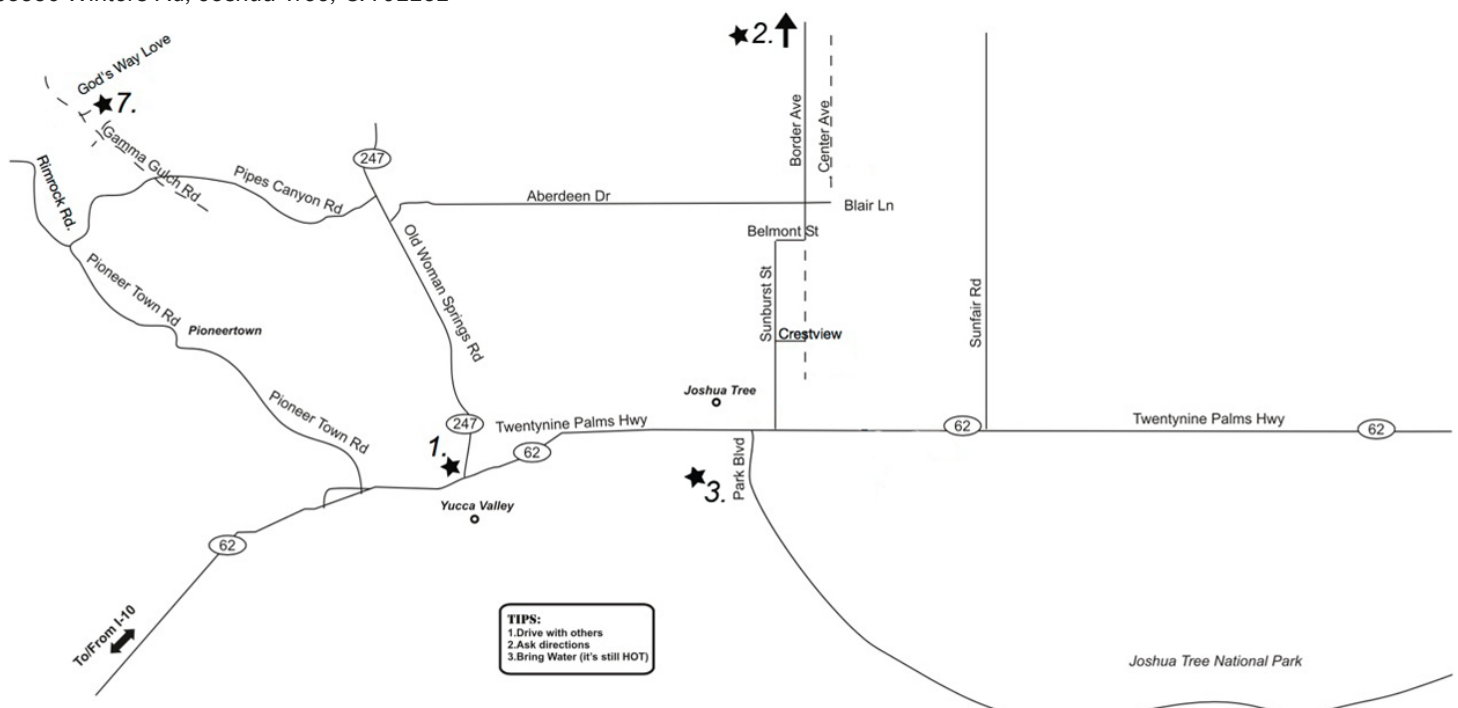
Trophy Modern House: Ry Rocklin and Carolyn Pennypacker Riggs

5. IRON AGE ROAD (WONDER VALLEY)

Chill Out: Oliver Payne — Saturday, 5:45pm

Listen to the ambient record by British acid house band the KLF as the sun sets across the desert. The event begins at 5:45 sharp. RULES: No late entry, no re-entry, no talking, no photography, no phones. Bring blankets and water, switch off, and listen.

From 29 Palms continue east on Hwy 62. Drive forever (23 miles) and turn left at Iron Age Rd. Drive until you see something. (Iron Age Rd connects both Amboy Rd and Hwy 62 so you can reach it using either access road.)

**The sand on Iron Age Road is especially loose right now. Drive slowly and carefully to not get stuck!*

7. ANDY'S GAMMA GULCH SITE (PIONEERTOWN)

Table Reading: Neil Doshi — Sunday, 1:30pm

A table reading acts as a prelude or rehearsal to an actual performance. In a reading, participants gather around a table and read their parts aloud, forcefully. Here, the script is scenes from a once-upon-a-time, true-story, utopian building project set in the high desert, the table will be the text that is to be read, and the reading will be done by the participants.

From 29 Palms Hwy turn right at Pioneertown Rd. Drive about 7.5 miles. Turn RIGHT on Pipes Canyon Rd. Drive 2.2 miles to Gamma Gulch Rd, turn LEFT (respect our neighbors - do not drive above 20 mph on this road!) Drive 1.6 miles to God's Way Love, turn RIGHT. Drive .4 miles.
